
### Pastor's Page

I'm writing this article during VBS week and what a joy it has been to have children back in the building this year. Seeing the smiling faces has been a great joy. More importantly a bigger joy for me is being able to tell these children about Jesus. For we know that it is Jesus that changes hearts and lives.

As I think about Jesus changing hearts and lives I think about where we are as a nation, after all the month of July we celebrate our nation's independence. We celebrate on July 4 our American freedoms. Our American Freedoms are a great gift that we have. I give thanks to God that we are a free nation and that we still do have the freedom to worship the way we are called to worship. I am thankful that we have the freedom to share the love of Jesus, if not by words, by our actions.

Over the last year and a half, as a nation, as a world we have struggled during this Covid-19 Pandemic. We have struggled to understand why this has happened to us now in the course of history. I sometimes think that it could be one of God's ways of calling us to repentance.
